



## Donation Yoga at Show Me Yoga Center September 5-December 31, 2006

**How does this work?** With Donation Yoga you can take as many classes as you like...and pay what you want! We will be accepting donations rather than set fees for all our classes this fall! You decide what your yoga class is worth to you and how much you can afford to pay. Simply leave your donation in the donation basket in your classroom. Generosity feels good and your generous donation helps to ensure that your yoga center will continue to provide our community with the gift of yoga. Donation Yoga works because you help spread the word, so invite your friends and neighbors!

**What if I already have a class card?** A few people still have class cards. You can continue using your class card until its expiration date or until you run out of credits. You decide how many credits to donate when you come to class. (Classes used to be 5 credits for 90-minute and 4 credits for 60-minute classes.)

**What is Easy Donate?** By popular request we offer the "Easy Donate" automatic charge to your credit card option. You choose the amount that you want to donate each month based on the number of classes you attend and your budget. There is a \$38 minimum and you can choose to start or stop anytime. Sign up at the front desk.

**Can I make my donation by check or credit card?** Yes, for your convenience we will continue to take MasterCard and Visa for donations. You may also donate by check or cash

**Can I donate something other than money?** Yes! We welcome your involvement. See the SMYC Wish List for goods and services that we could use to improve Show Me Yoga Center.

**Why should I donate to a business?** We have never made a profit. We hope to officially become a non-profit educational institution in the near future. In the meantime all income will go to pay operating expenses just as it has in the past.

**Can I register for class?** Class spaces will be available on a first-come, first-served basis, so plan to arrive a little early to ensure your space in class.

**Why are we doing this?** Two reasons. *First, we love to teach yoga.* It's never been about the money. We just want to teach!
